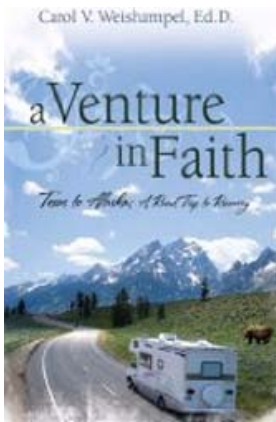


A Venture in Faith
