	Awning Operation	
	Generator for Leaks and Service (check for hours of operation on coach monitor)	
	Battery cables and batteries	
	Roof for chips, cracks, holes or bubbles	
	Roof vents for proper installation and/or damage	
	Antennas for damage (if applicable)	
	Tires for wear and date of tire manufacturer (sometimes on the inside of the tire)	
	Brake pads/shoes (if applicable)	
	Leaf springs, suspension, air bags and shocks for damage or possible bent frame	
	Refrigerator compartment for dust on coils, also recall modifications done	
	LP tanks for date code and complete LP drop test	
	Roof air conditioner for recent maintenance and operates according to specs	
	Fire extinguisher for service	
	Slide seals and slideouts for leaks	
	Water pump pressure test	
	Grey/Black tanks for leaks	
	Smoke detector and carbon dioxide detectors are operational	
	Leveling or stabilization system is working properly	
	Windshield wipers are operational	
	Oil level (look for window sticker) (if applicable)	
	Engine air filter (if applicable)	
	Transmission fluid and color (if applicable)	
	Coolant level and color (if applicable)	
	Brake fluid moisture test (if applicable)	
	Fluid leak check (if applicable)	
	All lube points (if applicable)	
	Fuel filter and fuel separator (if applicable)
